

9th Annual HyFyXs Super Six Tennis Ball Cricket Tournament

Sunday, 4th February 2024 – 8 am onwards

Tournament Rules & Regulations (updated on 2nd Feb'24):

Note: Changes to include tournament with 9 teams are highlighted in yellow.

The following rules and regulations will govern the HyFyXs – SUPER SIX – CRICKET TOURNAMENT. All teams and participants are advised to read the entire document.

Governing Rules:

- 1. The Tournament is open only to ex-students of Holy Family High School & Jr. College (caste, creed, religion, age, sex etc.- no bar).
- 2. The game is played between two teams, each having a single inning of 6 overs that will comprise of 6 legitimate balls each.
- 3. 10 players in a team {all 10 will play}. Players should submit proof of being an ex-student of Holy Family School or College.
- 4. Once the list of 10 players is submitted and the tournament is underway, no changes of names will be permitted.
- 5. All matches will be played with Tennis Cricket Balls supplied by the Organizers.
- 6. Canvas shoes. No spikes allowed.
- 7. The organizers will not be responsible for any cricketing gear except for tennis cricket ball and stumps.
- 8. The Organizers or the School will not be responsible for any injury that may occur to any player or any mishap while playing the tournament. Teams are advised to bring their own first aid kit. TEAMS WILL PLAY AT THEIR OWN RISK.
- 9. The umpire's decision will be final.

- 10. All matches will be on a KNOCK OUT basis. In the case of a Tie, outcome will be decided based on a "Super Over" as described hereinafter.
- 11. A maximum of 9 teams will be permitted to play in the tournament on a "first-come" basis. Thereafter no more entries will be accepted.
- 12. In the event, only 5 or 7 entries are received, or after first round there are 3 teams then there will be a "Bowl Out" amongst the losing teams to determine which of them will play the 3rd/6th/7th team; "Bowl Out" will consist of 6 bowlers bowling 1 delivery each. A total of only 6 deliveries allowed, whether legitimate or not. Hitting the unguarded stumps is the objective. The team with the maximum hits wins. Hits from illegitimate balls are not counted. In case of a tie after 6 deliveries each, the winner will be decided by sudden death the team that is ahead at the first or subsequent equal attempts is the winner. In sudden death too, the same set of 6 bowlers should bowl successively 1 delivery each until the outcome is determined.
- 13. If the batsman hits the ball and the ball goes directly outside on to the main road (behind the wickets) the batsman will be given out.
- 14. NO LBW
- 15. Before commencement of each inning, the batting team must declare their opening pair and who will take strike.
- 16. The draw will be conducted on Friday 2nd February 2024 in the school premises at 7.45 p.m.

Players Eligibility

- All players of each team must be Ex-Students of Holy Family High School and or junior college; each player must carry his/her identity proof and photo ID. Holy Family Ex Students Association ID card will be a valid proof; please carry sufficient proof.
- In the event a player is found NOT to be an Ex-Student of Holy Family High School, then that player and the team may be debarred and disqualified immediately. The opposite team may be granted a walk over.
- Also, if a person is substituted in a match for some reason, that person (who was substituted) is not eligible to play in the next match.

Free Hit

- 1. If a bowler delivers a ball overstepping the popping crease, the delivery will be deemed to be a NO BALL. Also, full toss above waist height and a bouncer above the head will also be deemed as NO BALL.
- 2. The batting team gets 1 run for the ball and the next delivery will be a free hit.
- 3. The batsman can only be dismissed through a run out in a free hit delivery.

Bowling Restrictions:

- 1. A bowler can bowl a maximum of 2 overs in an innings.
- 2. Only 2 Bowlers will be allowed to bowl a maximum of 2 overs each.
- 3. The remaining overs of the innings will have to be bowled by 2 other bowlers.
- 4. Bowlers will have a restricted run up of 13 steps; a clear mark will be made to ensure that there is no misunderstanding.
- 5. Only 1 Bouncer per over will be permitted

Power Play

- 1. There will be 1 Batting Power Play and 1 Bowling Power Play. Captains will decide when they wish to take the Power Play and will inform the Umpire accordingly. Any over of an innings may be selected to be a power play and fielding restrictions will apply; 6 players (including the wicket keeper) must be inside the circle and only 2 fielders will be permitted to stand outside the marked area of the circle.
- 2. In case any one side does not take power play, the last over will be the power play. Also, if both the teams do not take power play by 4th over, then the 5th overwill be bowling power play and the 6th over will be batting powerplay.

Tie Breaker

If, in any of the knockout matches, the scores of both the teams are level, then there will be a SUPER-OVER bowled; the team that scores the maximum RUNS in that SUPER over will be declared as the winner of that match.

Rules for Super Over are as follows:

- The Super Over will commence immediately after the main match.
- Each team bats one over consisting of six legal deliveries.
- The team batting second in the main match will bat first in the Super Over.
- The loss of two wickets ends the team's innings.
- In the event of the scores being level in the Super Over the outcome will be decided by a toss of the coin.

Match Timings & Punctuality

- 1. Teams will have to report 30 minutes prior to their match timings.
- 2. If a particular team is not available / present at the appointed time, then the opposing team may be awarded a walk over.
- 3. If any team has less number of players reporting on the day of the tournament, they may be permitted to play with less players provided they have a minimum of 6 players at least.
- 4. There will be no drinks break or any interval/s in any innings of the match.
- 5. Both Captains must report at least 10 minutes prior to the start time for their respective matches for the TOSS.

Penalties

- Each inning must be completed in 30 minutes; there will be no grace time given; If the fielding team fails to complete their allotted 6 overs in 30 minutes, then the batting team is awarded 5 extra runs for every extra 5 minutes or part thereof.
 In the event of deliberate time wasting by the batting side, or for any other extraneous reasons.
- 2. In case any player indulges in sledging or passes personal remarks on any other team player, then that player will be disqualified, and the team will have to play with a reduced number of players. This decision will be taken by the umpires' suo-moto or based on a complaint.
- 3. Umpires' and OC (Organizing Committee) decision will be final; Arguing with umpires may lead to disqualification of the player/team from the tournament. In the event of anyambiguity, they may consult the Organizing Committee for a final decision.

Innings Break:

- 1. There will be no breaks in between the innings.
- 2. There will be a 5-minute turnaround time between innings.
- 3. All players should be available and ready to take their field in 5 mins.

Entry Fees & Payment

- 1. Early Birds: The entry fee is Rs. 3,250 (Rupees Three thousand two hundred & fifty only) if the team is registered online & registration amount is paid by 26th Jan'24.
- 2. Entries received after 26th Jan'24, will be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee; the entry fee will be Rs. 4,000 (Rupees Four thousand only).
- 3. Entries are open till 1st Feb'24 or till 9 teams are registered.

Prizes / Awards (if there are 8 teams)

- 1. First Place Rs.6,500/- in cash for the team & mini trophies for 10 players of the team
- 2. Second Place Rs. 5,500/- in cash for the team & mini trophies for 10 players of the team
- 3. Best Batsman Rs. 750/- in cash (highest scorer of the Tournament) & mini trophy
- 4. Best Bowler Rs. 750/- in cash. (Highest wicket taker in the Tournament) & mini trophy
- 5. If there are less teams (4 to 7), all the above-mentioned prize money will be awarded on a pro-rata basis.
- 6. If there are less than 4 entries received on the date of the draw (Sat 3rd Feb'24), then the tournament will be cancelled, and all monies received will be refunded.

<mark>1</mark>	Winners Cash Prize will be increased by Rs. 1.5K i.e. from Rs. 5K to Rs. 6.5K
2	Runners Up Cash Prize will be increased by Rs. 1.5K i.e. from Rs. 4K to Rs. 5.5K
3	Play off for 4th place semi-finalist position will be decided between the Team Number 9 i.e. Team I and winning team from the 1st round that has the lowest net run rate. (Team Number 9 i.e. Team I will be selected based on the draws)
<mark>4</mark>	Reporting time for first 2 teams to play the match will be 7.30 am. Match should commence by 8 am the latest.
